2010 Chicago Region Club Racing Volunteer Recognition Program

1. This program applies only to the following Chicago Region events; Chicago Auto Show, Chicago Region Blackhawk Farms National and the Chicago Region Kettle Moraine National weekends.
2. The following are the available Chicago Region Specialties: Race Chairman, Registration, Grid & Pit, Steward, Tech Inspection, Flagging & Communications, Guest Services / Driver Information, Radio Tech, Sound Control, Starter, Rescue, Course Marshal, Paddock and Timing & Scoring.
3. This program is open to any volunteer, provided they are SCCA Members, (to include temporary memberships) from any Region.
4. Workers earn credits after completing specific volunteer days of a Specialty **under one of the four option plans listed below**. Combining days of more than one Specialty worked simultaneously is not allowed. Combining days under different options plans is not allowed.
5. A "day" is defined as working more than 90% of the available hours within a single day per the requirements of that specialty.
6. Each worker must have the designated Chief of that Specialty sign off on the attached credit submission card for each day of a weekend. Specialty Chiefs will have either the Race Chairman or Regional Executive sign off on their credit submission card. At the end of each race weekend, the Chief of each Specialty will provide a log of all signed cards within their Specialty that weekend to either the Race Chairman or Regional Executive. This log will be retained by the Region and is for reference only.
7. **It is the workers responsibility to submit their completed credit submission card to the Region. Cards must be received by the region by November 20, 2010. Late submissions will not be accepted** (see address on card, below). Completed cards may be mailed or will be accepted at the track after the final checkered flag of the final race weekend of the season. Paid or compensated staff is excluded from this program.
8. Chicago Region will credit you up to \$60.00 in any combination for national dues, merchandise from Joellyn Key Inc., Fastrack Safety or our Annual Dinner for each worker qualifying based selecting one of the five following option plans. If the worker is part of a Family or Spouse Membership, a maximum of \$90.00 will be credited to the Membership if submissions are received from more than one worker within the Family or Spouse Membership.
9. Credits will be sent to the SCCA National office or vendor in the workers name and will be credited to their account **only after November 20, 2010**. No cash will be given to members. Credits are non-transferable. The Chicago Region Board of Directors will address any questions and will review all credit submissions and reserves the right to reject any submissions it deems necessary.
